MISSION STATEMENT:

OBJECTIVES:

Laws, Ordinances, and Regulations:

- To support and promote practices and positions regarding public policy and government affairs that are in the best interests of the responsible development of commercial real estate, and to oppose those that are not.
- Eliminate and/or oppose any unnecessary statutory, regulatory, and local laws, ordinances, and regulations which make Nevada anti-competitive regionally or nationally.
- Support initiatives and efforts that lead to faster and more efficient development of commercial real estate, as well as affordable housing and high-density residential development.
- Educate NAIOP membership regarding new or changing laws, ordinances, and regulations.

Community Leadership Support:

- To support elected officials who have a history and proven track record of supporting the commercial real estate development industry.
- To information-share in real time with community and NAIOP leadership regarding emerging legal, regulatory, and economic issues.



Economic Development:

- Support local and state economic development agencies in their missions and be a resource when possible.
